

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
DOMINION WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT
REGARDING COMMERCIAL AND LIGHT INDUSTRIAL WATER DEMAND
STANDARDS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority contained in Title 32, Article I, Part 10, C.R.S., and § 29-1-203, C.R.S., Dominion Water & Sanitation District (“**Dominion**”) adopted its Amended and Restated Rules and Regulations on November 18, 2025, as may be amended from time to time (the “**Rules and Regulations**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority contained in Title 32, Article I, Part 10, C.R.S., and §29-1-203, C.R.S., Dominion has the authority to amend the Rules and Regulations from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Rules and Regulations provide the demand standards for retail water service connections for single-family and multi-family residential users (“**Residential Service Connections**”) but does not contemplate demand standards for retail water service connections for non-residential users (“**Non-Residential Service Connections**”); and

WHEREAS, Dominion has implemented water efficiency standards that effectively minimize indoor and outdoor water usage for retail water service connections. These standards are imperative for efficient water usage and will be applicable to Non-Residential Service Connections; and

WHEREAS, Dominion is in the process of developing demand standards that account for water efficiency for Non-Residential Service Connections; and

WHEREAS, Dominion wishes to clarify application of the Rules and Regulations as to the demand standards for Non-Residential Service Connection as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF DOMINION (THE “**BOARD**”), AS FOLLOWS:

1. Application of the Rules and Regulations to Non-Residential Service Connections. The Rules and Regulations shall not be interpreted to provide the demand standards for Non-Residential Service Connections, including all forms of commercial and industrial use, until such a time as the Rules and Regulations are amended to include the demand standards for Non-Residential Service Connections.

2. Non-Residential Service Connection Demand Standards. The District will perform an individual analysis to determine water usage, availability of water and the appropriate fees associated with the water demands for any Non-Residential Service Connections occurring prior to an amendment to the Rules and Regulations as contemplated in Paragraph 1.

3. Irrigation for Non-Residential Service Connections. Notwithstanding anything in this Resolution, all Non-Residential Service Connections shall comply with Dominion's water efficiency standards as adopted.

4. Service Fees. Any changes to service fee rates will be made in compliance with § 32-1-1001(2)(a), C.R.S. and Dominion's Rules and Regulations.

5. Severability. If any portion of this Resolution is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Resolution which shall remain in full force and effect, the intention being that such portions are severable. In addition, in lieu of such void or unenforceable provision, there shall automatically be added as part of this Resolution a provision similar in terms to such illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision so that the resulting reformed provision is legal, valid and enforceable.


6. Ratification. All provisions of the Prior Rules and Regulations not expressly modified by this Resolution shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
